

VOICES OF INFLUENCE YOUTH POETRY SLAM
OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS

1. NO PURCHASE NECESSARY TO ENTER. All federal, state and local regulations apply. Void in Florida and where prohibited by law. Contest dates January 13, 2007-February 25, 2007.

2. TO ENTER. Contest is available to all metro Atlanta youth ages 13-18. Youth will be directed to come to auditions with a completed application, which will include name, date of birth, complete address, and telephone number. Application will be available at V103 office. Youth participating that are ages 13-17 must have a parent/guardian present and must have a permission slip signed by a parent/guardian along with completed application. After registration period at each location, twenty-five (25) applications that are completed properly and that have permissions slips properly filled out (if applicable) will be pulled randomly to participate in auditions. Auditions will take place on the following days:
 - I. Sunday, January 13, 2007 3p-6p ages 13-14 Registration 2PM-2:30PM
 - II. Saturday, January 20, 2007 3p-6p ages 15-16 Registration 2PM-2:30PM
 - III. Saturday, February 3, 2007 3p-6p ages 17-18 Registration 2PM-2:30PM

Locations will be announced on air and via web. Entrants must perform and original piece. Original piece must be no longer than three minutes and must incorporate the theme "Voices of Influence" leaders, innovators, etc. that have influenced society and/or community. Each audition will include a panel of judges that will select five (5) semi finalists who will then compete at the final Voice of Influence Youth Poetry Slam taking place at Center Stage Atlanta 1374 West Peachtree Street, Atlanta, Georgia 30309 Sunday, February 25, 2007 at 4:00 PM. Entrants will receive points in decimal point system from one (1) through ten (10); the highest and lowest scores denoted by the judges will be eliminated and the remaining scores will be totaled. The person with the highest score will win. Entrant must audition during their age group only. No second chances will be given.

3. For the final competition at Center Stage Atlanta, all semi finalists must arrive at the final competition between 3:00pm and 3:30 pm on Sunday, February 26, 2006. All semi finalist arriving after 3:30pm Eastern Standard Time are subject to be disqualified. Entrants will receive points in the Decimal point system from one (1) through ten (10); the highest and the lowest score denoted by the judges will be eliminated and the remaining scores will be totaled. The person with the highest score will win. In the event of a tie the remaining qualified entrants must perform a new original piece. For the tie breaker entrants will receive points in

the Decimal point system from one (1) through ten (10); the highest and the lowest scores denoted by the judges will be eliminated and the remaining scores will be totaled. The person with the highest score will win. Entrant will be judged on content, delivery and overall performance. As in the preliminary auditions the piece perform by the entrants must be no longer than (3) minutes in length. At three minutes the entrants will receive a ten (:10) second grace period. After the grace period five-tenths (.5) of a point is deducted every ten (:10) seconds the entrants continues there piece.
